

## **OPERATION FELIX TAKES TO THE STREETS**

After two years of extensive research, filming in Germany, France, Spain, Gibraltar and using the support of over seventy seven re-enactors and stuntmen, Gibraltar born British producer Martin Nuza is set to present his latest documentary called "Operation Felix: Hitler's key to victory".

The distributor in Germany is very pleased with the programme, which although difficult in itself due to its complexity has conveyed his personal exhilaration to Mr. Nuza, saying that "knowing of the passion Martin has for filmmaking and how well he uses the editing suite with his never ceasing creativity and determination, he had faith the end result would be a good documentary but never imagined it would have turned out so exciting and excellently documented, produced and edited in a complete 60 minute special", he also praised the writer of the script Alfonso Escuadra for his outstanding draft.

Already there are over thirty interested parties which include TV stations from England, France, Germany, Japan, Spain, Poland and America who have showed a keen interest in the documentary. Some of the names include History channel, National Geographic (International channel) and the discovery channel amongst many other well known channels worldwide, promising to undeniably give plenty of exposure to Gibraltar.

We are told that a DVD of the documentary, including many special features, one of which is the complete assault at Eastern beach by the Germans will be available in a number of outlets in Gibraltar, Mr. Nuza has demanded that the distributor retail the DVD at a low price in Gibraltar so that everyone who has a passion for history can easily afford it. This documentary also has many original scenes of Gibraltar during the Second World War and the material contained within the archive footage in the documentary is a treasure in itself. Unedited material that include the Germans training in France in 1940 to capture Gibraltar and many other footage that has never before seen the light of day due to censors which have only just been lifted, in time for this documentary to be completed.

The documentary has been narrated by the very professional Peter Canessa and all German interviews have been narrated by the equally professional David Hoare and Ken Anthony. Music has been composed by Ernest H. Slade from Eazi-K. Jim Crone from [discovergibraltar.com](http://discovergibraltar.com) was the official photographer for Gold Productions Studios and he has made some very exciting shots which will also appear throughout this documentary. Some local participation in the re-enacting is also visible by Gibraltarians. Mr. Nuza's wishes for local participation in all fields are present; both in front and behind the camera and his wishes have been clearly granted. He is very happy at the end result, never doubting for one moment that it could not have been made, especially after sacrificing so much at a personal level for this documentary to have been completed.
